Comprehensive connotations of siddha external therapy terminologies in T.V. sambasivam pillai siddha medical dictionary

Abstract

Siddha system of Medicine (SSM) is the ancient medical system flourished on par with the civilization of Southern part of India. In SSM, 32 types of Siddha External Therapy (SET) and procedures play a major role in treating diseases which are described by *Siddhar Theraiyar*. Apart from *Theraiyar*, Various *Siddhars* have also explained SET in the Siddha literatures. Being SET has vital role in clinical practice; a comprehensive connotation about its terminologies is needed. Proper understanding and clear explanations for the technical Siddha terms can be mostly obtained through "T.V.Sambasivam Pillai Siddha Medical Dictionary (Tamil - English) / TVS Dictionary". The Siddha Encyclopedia and Android application for Research Community and Health care institutions (SEARCHⁱ) Project team had analyzed all the terminologies and identified 1037 terminologies related with SET from the entire 86,618 terminologies of this Dictionary. The identified SET terminologies were assorted into 4 main categories. One of the categories, Siddha External Therapy as per *Siddhar Theraiyar* (SET) was further categorized in to 32 classes. T.V.Sambasivam Pillai (TVS) elaborated SET terminologies in several aspects like synonyms, vernacular names, equivalent modern terminologies, different school of thoughts, treatment methodology etc. Emphasizing the need for globalized use, standardization with respect to research for further comprehension and analysis are needed. This Dictionary is the notable work for extensive collection of SET terminologies which can be used by Researchers, Students community and Academicians for their all research works, reference purpose and to know the depth meaning and associated contents. By knowing these terminologies one can take out the hidden treasures present in ancient Siddha literatures.

Introduction

Siddha system of Medicine (SSM) is the ancient medical system flourished on par with the civilization of Southern part of India. Siddhars, the intellectual giants have understood the cosmic reflections and their effect on human body, benefit of the natural materials and using them for wellness. This has later evolved as a medical system called Siddha system of Medicine. Siddha system has consummated, literary expression in the field of medicine. Siddhars have documented their knowledge in non-codified manner using Tamil poem as a tool which has been later codified. 32 types of Internal medicine and 32 types of External therapies were mentioned by the Siddhar Theraiyar. 1 Being Siddha External Therapy (SET) has vital role in clinical practice; a comprehensive connotation about its terminologies is needed. The legend T.V. Sambasivam Pillai (TVS) has brought out the Medical Dictionary in the year 1931 by his tiresome efforts. This T.V.Sambasivam Pillai Siddha Medical Dictionary (Tamil - English) / TVS Dictionary is the most comprehensive medical dictionary which explained the numerous terminologies with definition and descriptions like Encyclopedia. So this is one of the best literatures to search whatever we need about Siddha system.²

Material and Methods

TVS Dictionary has 5 volumes, and which is expanded to eight books, extending up to 7095 pages. This dictionary not only deals with the medical terminologies but also other life science terminologies. The Tamil - English meaning and explanation of 86,618 terminologies were described. "The

Siddha Encyclopedia and Android application for Research Community and Health care institutions (SEARCHⁱ)" is the Intra Mural Research project proceeding in the Literary Research and Documentation Department (LR & DD), Siddha Central Research Institute (SCRI), Chennai. The SEARCHⁱ project team had analyzed the entire terminologies and cull out the terminologies which are specially and specifically related to SET. These SET terminologies were assorted in 4 main categories. They are

- 1. Siddha External Therapy mentioned by *Siddhar Theraiyar* SET
- 2. Siddha medicines used for external therapy SMET
- 3. Siddha External Therapy Treatment procedures SETP
- Other External Therapy which are mentioned in various Siddha literatures - OET

The category, SET is further assorted into 32 categories. These categories are mentioned in the Table I.

Results and Discussion

Literary analysis shows that there are 1037 terminologies which are related with SET among the total 86,618 terminologies. SET terminologies cover 1.2 % of this dictionary. A substantial amount of SET terminologies had been discussed elaborately in this dictionary.

The identified SET terminologies were assorted into 4 main categories. Among the SET terminologies, 833 terminologies were placed under SET category, 122 terminologies in SMET category, 138 terminologies in SETP category and 42 terminologies in OET category. The Figure I show the proportionate of the 4 main categories.

SET was further categorized in to 32 classes. In the further categorization of SET, 6 terminologies were placed in the category Attai vidal, 97 in Aruvai, 01 in Urinjal, 0 in Oodhal, 30 in Ottradum, 60 in Kattu, 15 in Kali, 33 in Kallikkam, 27 in Kalimbu, 34 in Kaaram, 07 in Keeral, 06 in Kuruthi vaangal, 24 in Kombu kattal, 03 in Salaagai, 21 in Suttigai, 62 in Seelai, 43 in Thokkanam, 11 in Nasiyam, 15 in Naasikabaranam, 25 in Neer, 12 in Pasai, 21 in Patru, 21 in Peechchu, 54 in Pugai, 107 in Poochchu, 07 in Podi, 09 in Podi thimirthal, 07 in Pottanam, 0 in Murichchal, 38 in Mai, 19 in Varththi and 18 in Vethu. The Figure II shows the

proportionate of the sub category of the Siddha External Therapy mentioned by *Siddhar Theraiyar*- SET.

TVS elaborated SET terminologies in several aspects like synonyms, vernacular names, equivalent modern terminologies, different school of thoughts, treatment methodology, medicine preparations etc. Other external therapies which are not comes under SET but usually practiced in SSM are also markedly explained by TVS. For example, a few of SET terminologies are discussed in each category in the Tables (from Table 2 to Table 4)

Sinega pottanam ⁸	Ci <u>n</u> ēka Poṭṭaṇam	A bundle is which required drugs are tied and soaked heated oil or medicinal oil and used for fomentation.
Upputh thiri ⁹	Upput Tiri	A twist soaked in a preparation of salt and inserted into the anus of a child to serve as a suppository for drawing out the fecal matter in cases of constipation.

Sarva rana mulaam ⁵	Carva Raņa Mulām	A healing plaster applied to will kinds of wounds and injuries. It is made by powdering and then grinding frank-incense, blue vitriol, black and white dammer in gingelly oil and then washing the product in water and steeping it on a white cloth.	
Padarthaamaraith thailam ⁴	Paṭartāmarait Tailam	An oil extracted from the mixture of coconut, aconite, unbroken areca nut, sal ammoniac, seeds of nux-vomica, silver nitrate, white part of dog's dung. It is applied for ringworm, eczema etc.	
Pancha poosana thailam ⁴	Pañcapūṣaṇa Tailam	A bathing medicated oil prepared with the following drugs; liquorice root or root of honey creeper, cinnamon bark, sarsaparilla, black cumin seeds and <i>coray</i> root (<i>cyperus pertenuis</i> root).	
Mano maguda dhoobam ⁴	Maṇōmakuṭatūpam	A fumigating powder of above mentioned drugs for fever and to purify the air to prevent air borne diseases.	
Nellaikkaaip patru ⁷	Nellikkāyppa <u>rr</u> u	A paste of Indian gooseberry after removing the nut is a useful external application over the pubic region in irritability or inflammation of the bladder.	


